PREPONDERANCE

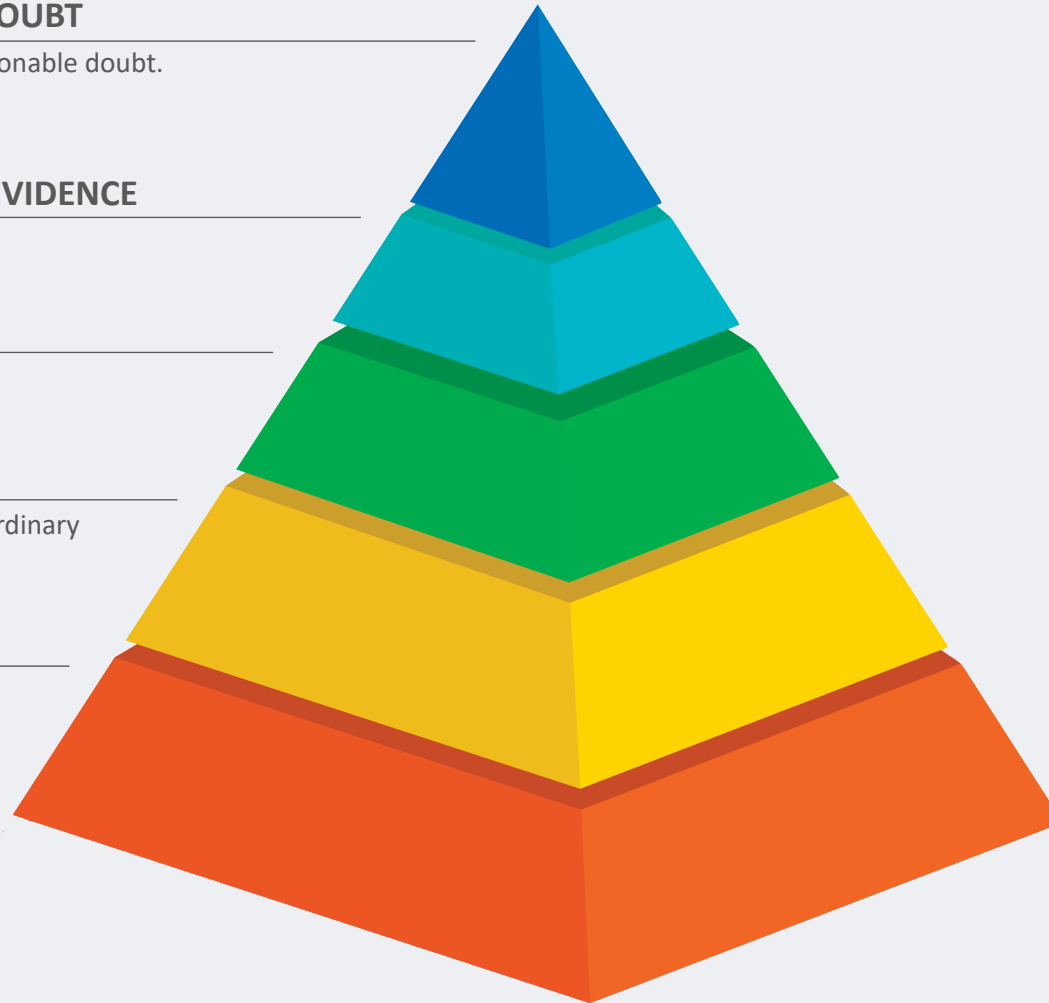
More likely than not.
