
CORE IQ HISTORICAL LESSONS - HOUDINI






VALUES: Houdini had defined his core values and was strictly honest. When he saw disreputable psychics taking advantage of people, he

assisted the police in their investigation.












WRITING: While having a limited formal education, Houdini used time management techniques and consistently wrote a page at a time until it added up to a book. In all, Houdini wrote seven books!

SOCIAL SKILLS: Houdini liked people and used several thriving behaviors to be selected as the president of the Society of Magicians, which still operates today.
